Eden Area ROP Food Drive

Eden Area ROP has labeled December as the month for giving back. Eden Area ROP Hosted a food drive for the Alameda County Community Food Bank. On Thursday, November 18 the First Responders participated in the state mandated disaster preparedness drill for hospitals in Alameda Co. The scenario was that bombs were exploding in and around Hayward. The students were given scenarios for different injuries and they matriculated through the hospital. Some of the injuries required surgery, and three of the students went through the decontamination tent for victims exposed to toxic chemicals.
