

REOPENING FAQ

Q: When will the Eden Area ROP reopen?

- A: We are following the requirements of the county and statewide Public Health regarding safely reopening schools. There are three major factors affecting our ability to reopen:
 - 1. <u>Public Health Requirements</u>: Currently, our county must be in the red tier for 5 consecutive days prior to be eligible for reopening.
 - 2. <u>Partner Districts Reopening Plans:</u> We have to work within the reopening plans of our partner districts to develop a schedule for center programs that works with the schedules developed by our partner districts.
 - 3. <u>Transportation:</u> Contracting with bus companies for transportation requires dates, drop off and pick up times that can only be determined once we have a schedule set.

Q: Do I have to return if the Eden Area ROP opens?

A: Any student who wants to remain on distance learning will be given the opportunity remain on distance learning.

Q: Will there be testing if the Eden Area ROP reopens?

A: Currently, there is no requirement for testing for schools to reopen.
